- ❖ Our estimated Tour attendance was 646. Forty-one businesses supported the Tour through either cash or in-kind sponsorships, door prizes or refreshments. Twenty individuals supported the mission by becoming Friends of the Tour. Additionally local residents baked cookies, served as Hosts or provided music.
- ❖ **Our ticket sales totaled a record-breaking \$10,710!** Of the people who attended, 114 completed a Survey. From those surveys, we know we had people from not only Woodland Park, but also Colorado Springs, Divide, Florissant, Cascade, Green Mountain Falls, Manitou Springs, Peyton, Aurora, Lake George, Longmont, Pueblo, Fountain, Centennial, Canon City, Highlands Ranch and even Casper, WY! And we once again welcomed the Cheyenne Mountain Newcomers Club from Colorado Springs.
- ❖ Our Media Partners played a crucial role in "spreading the word." A special thank you goes to KKTV Channel 11, Pikes Peak Courier, The Mountain Jackpot, Ute Country News, SOAR Nonprofit Cooperative, Woodland Park Living Magazine, the City of Woodland Park and Lighter Side of Christmas Parade.
- ❖ And the final result: **net proceeds totaled \$15,167.** The Home Tour retains 10% for replacement items as needed such as light pole banners, garland, etc. On January 6, 2022, the balance was distributed to our 2021 Beneficiaries ~ **Friends of Mueller State Park, Habitat for Humanity of Teller County, Teller Senior Coalition and Woodland Park Players.**
