Our “snow or shine” event entitles the visitor admittance to each home ONCE during the tour. Tickets purchased online are available for pick up at Woodland Professional Building.

Refreshments and restrooms are available at our Hospitality Locations: Woodland Professional Building, Woodland Park Senior Center, and Tweeds Fine Furnishings.

The QR code on each ticket provides electronic access to our Tour Guide. Tour Guides are also available at our three Hospitality Locations. The Tour Guide includes a map, written directions, and a QR code to each venue. Highway signage will also assist in navigating to our seven homes and three Hospitality Locations.

Shoe covers are provided at each home, or feel free to bring your own slippers.

Each home is marked with Holiday Home Tour signage and parking instructions where needed. Please respect the designated parking areas for our volunteer musicians and host. **Note: It is a short walk between the Randall and Stuckey homes.**

Photo opportunities are available at our Hospitality Locations. Out of respect for the homeowners, photography and videography are NOT permitted at the homes.
